Monkeyland is renowned for rehabilitation work with primates. Join a one-hour safari and see various species of primates - monkeys, apes and lemurs - move about freely in the forested sanctuary. The transfer of information by multi-lingual game rangers about these fascinating creatures enhances your visit to the sanctuary.

The Birds of Eden sanctuary is the largest free-flight aviary in the world - spanning over a gorge of indigenous forest, with a canopy walk that hangs above the clouds. A large collection of African birds and miniature monkeys have been released into the sanctuary after undergoing rehabilitation. There is a mysterious ruin and a walk-behind a waterfall

Elephant Sanctuary - the elephants have been domesticated through positive reinforcement animal management principles, and as a result, provide us with the unique opportunity to interact with them. Visitors are able to touch, feed and get to know them, as well as walk hand-in-trunk with them - an unforgettable experience.



Tenikwa Wild Cat Sanctuary - Meet captive-bred furry felines in their semi-natural surroundings on a guided tour or join the cheetahs on their daily walk in the forest as they romp around and play in the indigenous forest and fynbos. (Booking essential)
